NZFSA Industry Standard 3. Section 17.4 – Protective Clothing. In part 17.4.5.1 a requirement is made for impervious gloves to have been proven to have satisfied the composition and conditions of use requirements for indirect food additives (polymers) specified in the current US Code of Federal Regulations, Title 21, Part 177 (CFR 177). The composition and conditions of use are not required, only proof that the gloves meet them. No other disposable consumable protective clothing requires this as they (smocks, aprons, sleeves, hats etc) are only in intermittent contact with the meat product.
